

Lantern Pole Construction

Lanterns are utilized during the second year of the program. Please take time to construct a lantern pole that is functional and safe to handle. You will receive your Y Guides kerosene lantern as well as your tool kit with your second year supplies. When you fill your lantern, only use Kerosene or Lantern Oil. We hope you will continue to use your lantern any time you have a camp-out. Remind your Guide to treat fire with respect. Always supervise the handling of the flame with your child.

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- 1/16" drill bit
- Drill
- · Replacement broom handle
- 1 Eye hook (supplied in 2nd year kit)
- 1 Carabiner (supplied in 2nd year kit)



Steps to building your Y Guides lantern:

STEP 1: Using the 1/16" bit and electric drill, pre drill a hole about 1" from the end of the broom handle. Do not go all the way through the handle.



STEP 2: Insert the eye hook into the predrilled hole.
Tighten until snug.



STEP 3: Attach the carabiner to eye hook.



STEP 4(optional): Decorate broom handle with tape, paint, etc.
